Insurance: Participants must be insured against illness, accidents and third-party liabilities according to Rotary Internat. recommendations.

You will participate in activities both on land, in- and on water with a particular focus on safety on- and around water.

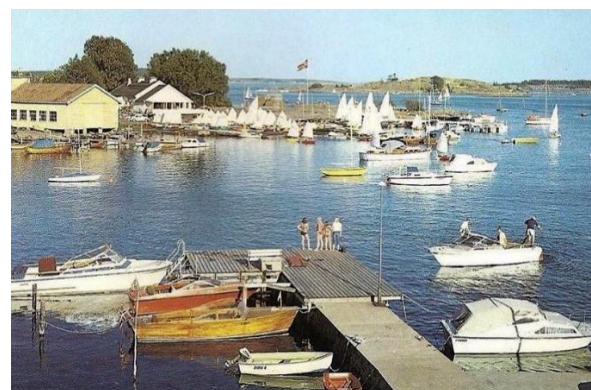
Let's meet up in Horten this summer!

Bø Rotary Club 12.-15. August

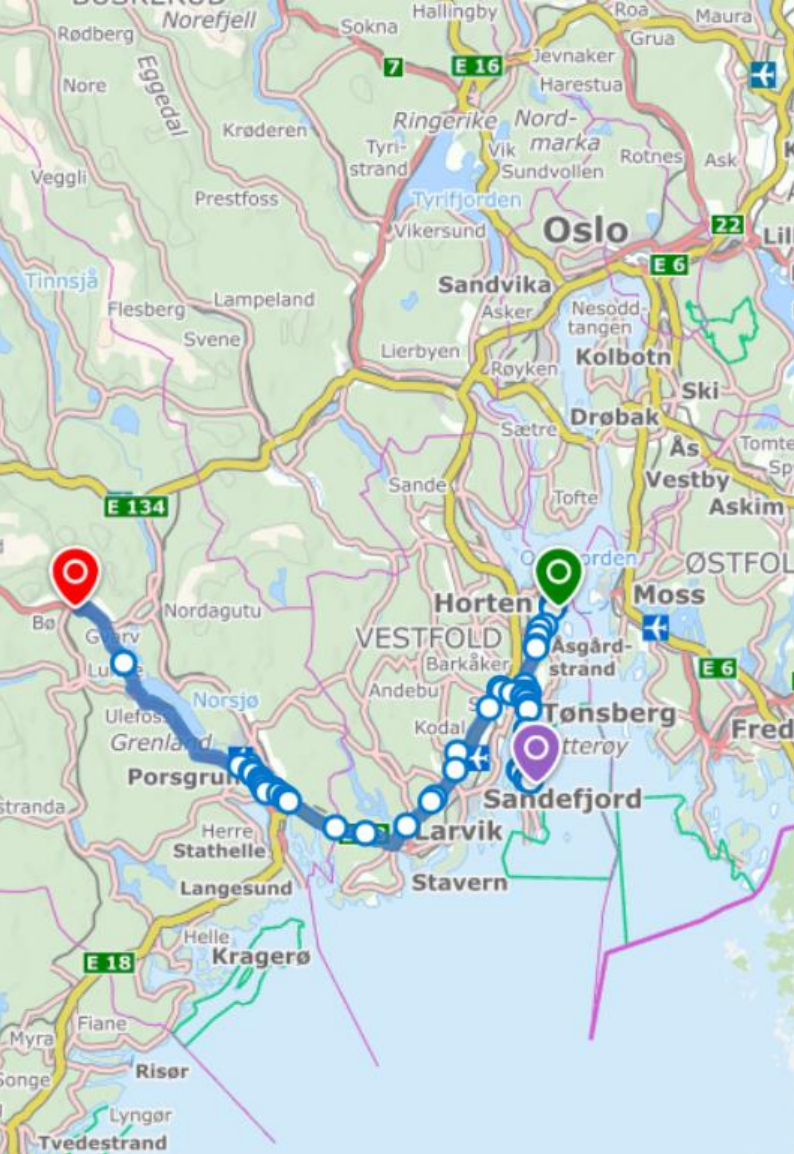
