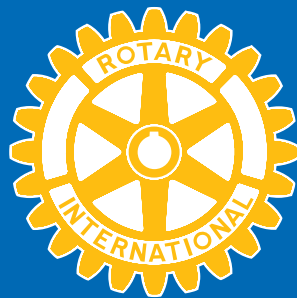


INVITATION TO ROTARY SUMMER CAMP

PROGRAM

Departure: 12. August from Stavanger Airport, Sola (drop-off at 12:00). Earliest possible departure 14:00

Participants: 12 boys and girls, maximum two from each country

Age: 16-17 years

Accommodation: In hostels, private homes or cottages. You must be prepared to share room.

Language: English

Costs: EUR 300 + pocket money and travel expenses to and from Norway

Clothing: Summer clothes, including swimsuit, warm clothes, rain- and wind jacket and good hiking shoes

Food: Traditional Norwegian food. Please inform us if you have any food restrictions

Insurance: Participants must be insured against illness, accidents and third-party liabilities according to Rotary International recommendations.

Acceptance: Applications will be considered in order of being received. Still the gender balance will be in focus.
